Pastor's Report

Finance

The Executive Committee will review submitted committee budgets at the November 3rd meeting. The congregation will vote on the budget at the November 16th service budget presentation (after the Sunday service).

We have an opportunity to develop a "interior decorating" special project to enhance our fellowship and gathering space. This will result in developing a separate line item on the budget.

We are investigating a possible columbarium to be erected on the church property. This would be made from metal or heavy plastic and could be transportable.

Property

The Tagge Farm lease will be drafted (TBD) for the 2026 calendar year.

We had an excellent turn-out for the clean-up project.

There has been excellent support for the blanket ministry.

The committee's priority is the Sub for Santa holiday event.
